## Wireframe Notes

1. Users enter their email if they saved it on a previous visit to speed up the check-in process.
2. This clears the email field.
3. Error messaging appears upon clicking the Start Check-in button if they email isn't one the system has previously saved.

If an invalid email address is entered, the user sees:

**You must enter a valid email address.**

**Wireframe Notes**

1. Informs the user of their progress.
2. Adjust the number by clicking the plus or minus buttons or by typing it in. The value cannot be less than 1 or above 4.
3. This number can be modified the same way as the field above. The value can not be less than 1 or above 9.
4. Entering an email address speeds up the check-in process the next time. This can be left blank.
5. Checking this box adds the user to the digital mailing list.
6. Returns the user to the Entry Point. (See page 2)
7. If there are no field-level validation errors, the user is taken to Step 2 of the process. See the next page to learn what happens when errors are present.

## Wireframe Notes

1. If any field-level validation errors are present when *Continue* is clicked, a message appears at the top of the page. It disappears as soon as all of the errors are corrected.
2. An error appears if the user enters zero for adult attendees. If the user enters 5 or higher they will receive the error:  
  
A maximum of 4 adults can attend.  
  
This error disappears as soon as it is corrected.
3. An error appears if the number of children is zero. If seven or more children are indicated, the following appears:  
  
A maximum of 6 children may attend.
4. An error appears if the user leaves the postal code empty or incorrectly enters the last 3 digits.
5. An error appears if no boxes are checked for relationship(s).

**Wireframe Notes**

1. If the user has selected to skip the additional questions or has already answered all of the questions previously this will appear as: Step 1 of 1
2. The email address is displayed to ensure the correct account is being accessed.
3. Information that was used last time is already filled out to speed up the process.
4. Users receive emails regarding the centre only if this box is checked. They can choose to select or de-select this box at anytime. This box is selected by default.
5. Users check this box if they want to skip the optional questions on the next page. Note that clicking this box makes the title change to: Step 1 of 1  
  
This box is deselected by default.
6. Clicking *Cancel* returns the user to "Child Care Check-in Wireframes - Entry Point", see page 2.
7. Clicking *Continue* takes the user to "Child Care Check-in Wireframes - Check-in Complete", see page 8.

**Wireframe Notes**

1. Users choose to answer of all, any or none of these questions. If all of the questions are answered the check-box on the previous page annotated as "5" will automatically be checked. They will not be presented with this screen again, unless that box is unchecked.
2. Users select one option from the drop-down to tell us how they heard about our program.
3. Users select one option from the drop-down to tell us their preferred language.
4. Users enter any comments about the program.
5. Takes users to "Child Care Check-in Wireframes - Step 1: Repeat Check-in", see page 6.
6. Takes the user to "Child Care Check-in Wireframes - Check-in Complete", see page 8.

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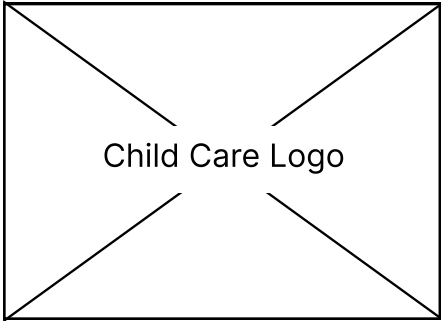
